Business Description

- Founded in late 2005, DigitalBridge Communications (DBC) provides broadband wireless to underserved rural, suburban, military, and university communities through the new WiMAX technology standard.
- DBC is focused on bringing fixed broadband access to underserved towns of 10,000 to 75,000, a market that represents over 5,800 towns and nearly 40 million Americans.
- The Company is a well-funded startup run out of Ashburn, Virginia, backed by RedShift Ventures, CNF Investments, Novak Biddle Venture Partners, and a few prominent technology investors.
- DBC owns Teton Wireless and Montana Wireless, providers of Internet services to about 11,000 customers in Idaho and Montana. DBC is enhancing the offerings in these markets by adding higher speed data services.

Operations

- In June, 2007, DBC launched one of the first commercial WiMAX systems in the United States in Rexburg, Idaho.
- The company is rolling out service to communities in the Intermountain West, Midwest, and Southeast, where it has negotiated leases for spectrum covering over 1.2 million additional people.
- DBC's business plan calls for it to obtain spectrum covering nearly 20 million people, allowing the company to serve 150,000 subscribers in the next three to five years.
- DBC's strong, growing business benefits from the low-capital costs of WiMAX deployments and the service's high subscriber self-install rates. Building on the advantages of WiMax economics, DBC has developed a highly scalable network deployment and variable-cost based back office platform that enables the Company to bring broadband to communities nationwide.

Local Community Support

- DBC is also committed to working with communities and schools to make high speed services available to local residents and students. The Company looks forward to becoming an integral part of each community that it serves. DBC expects to create local partnerships with universities and schools similar to the relationship it has established with Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana.
